Children's and Youth Division Class Guidelines

During the school year we offer our classes in two semesters, Fall and Spring. The Fall Semester is 17-weeks in length and the Spring Semester is 16-weeks in length.

Serendipity, **age 3.5-6.** Classes are labeled on the schedule to indicate age groupings. Some children do well with a wider age range in class, others need a smaller range. All classes are taught with developmentally appropriate movement and expectations for the age group in mind.

Pre-Ballet, age 6-8. Classes are labeled on the schedule to indicate age groupings. Some children do well with a wider age range in class, others need a smaller range. All classes are taught with developmentally appropriate movement and expectations for the age group in mind.

For Ballet 1 to Ballet 3, each level is completed over the course of 2 years, so students who enroll in Ballet 1 for this school year will continue in the class for the next school year unless the teacher recommends they move up early (usually based on age and the interest of keeping kids in their peer group together).

Ballet 1: age 8-12, Ballet 2: 11-14, Ballet 3: 12-15, Ballet 4/5: 14-18

Students are evaluated for pointe at about 11 years of age and must have attended 2 classes per week for at least 1 year in preparation. Consistent attendance is required for pointe evaluation.

Students placed in Ballet 4/5 may also enroll in Repertory Ensemble. Must be enrolled in the number of classes offered for this level, all Ballet classes with Modern Jazz optional.

Modern 1/2, age 10-14

This is a great class to pair with Ballet classes for a well rounded experience in movement, technique and building strength.

Modern Jazz 4/5, age 13-18

Available to students who are currently enrolled at Danspace, or with prior experience of at least 3 years ballet or modern dance elsewhere.
